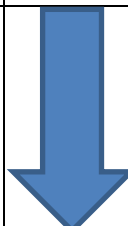

WARM UP GUIDELINES

All lanes in the Competition Pool are **CIRCLE SWIMMING ONLY** until 45 minutes before the published time of the end of warm-up, when the competition pool converts to the following diagram:

COMPETITION POOL (50m):

- There is NO DIVING OR BACKSTROKE STARTS AT ALL until 45 min. prior to the end of warm up, and then diving or backstroke starts only in those lanes marked to do so.
- There is NO DIVING IN CIRCLE SWIMMING LANES, entry to these lanes is to be FEET FIRST. Circle swimming is anti-clockwise.
- **No equipment other than a kickboard or pull buoy is allowed in the Competition Pool (50m) (e.g., no paddles, fins, rubber bands, parachutes, etc.).**
- At any time between sessions, the Competition Pool must be set up as described above.

WARM UP POOL (50m):

- All lanes will be anti-clockwise circle swimming with FEET FIRST ENTRY at all times.
- Lanes zero (0) and nine (9) can be used for dive-in, sprints, backstroke or relay exchange practice. The starting blocks must reflect the blocks used in the competition pool.
- Backstroke ledges should also be available in the warm-up pool.

WARM UP POOL (25m):

- All the equipment is allowed in the warm-up pool (25m).
- Only lanes one (1) and eight (8) can be used for dive-in sprints or relay exchange practice.
- **Beware of the low ceiling above the start blocks.**

World Aquatics Technical Swimming Committee reserves the right to modify the above guidelines if circumstances so require.

LANES

The athletes will be placed in the lanes according to their official times.

CALL ROOMS

Athletes will meet at the CALL ROOM 1 (1st floor under the seating area), proceed to the CALL ROOM 2 (ground floor, close to start block 9) and then to the FINAL CALL ROOM (behind start block 5, start side).

All call rooms will be clearly marked.

Athletes must report to the call room no later than 10 minutes prior to their scheduled start.

OPENING CEREMONY

- Each country will participate with 1 female and 1 male athlete. Please make sure the representatives present themselves on the pool deck 15 minutes before the opening ceremony,, where they will be given further instructions.
- The teams will march in alphabetical order from the assembly point to the awards ceremony stage. The host country will appear last.
- Welcome speech by the President of the Slovenian Swimming Association, Mr. Urban Korenjak.
- Official opening of the event. Slovenian national anthem.
- Athletes leave the pool. Arrival of the swimming officials.

AWARDS

- Medals shall be awarded for top 3 placing for each age group.
- The male and the female athlete who each achieve the highest points score , as determined by the AQUA Points Table, will each receive a special trophy.
- The point score in team competition for individual events shall be: 1st place 9 points, 2nd place 7 points, 3rd place 6 points, 4th place 5 points, 5th place 4 points, 6th place 3 points, 7th place 2 points, 8th place 1 point.
- The point score in team competition for relay events doubles: 1st place 18 points, 2nd place 14 points, 3rd place 12 points, 4th place 10 points, 5th place 8 points, 6th place 6 points, 7th place 4 points, 8th place 2 points.
- Three federation with the highest total number of points, awarded in individual and relay events will receive the CECJM Trophy in both men's and women's categories.
- The national anthem of the winner shall be played only during the Final Ceremony and the flag of the country shall be hoisted.

AWARD CEREMONIES

Award ceremonies will be held according to the program.

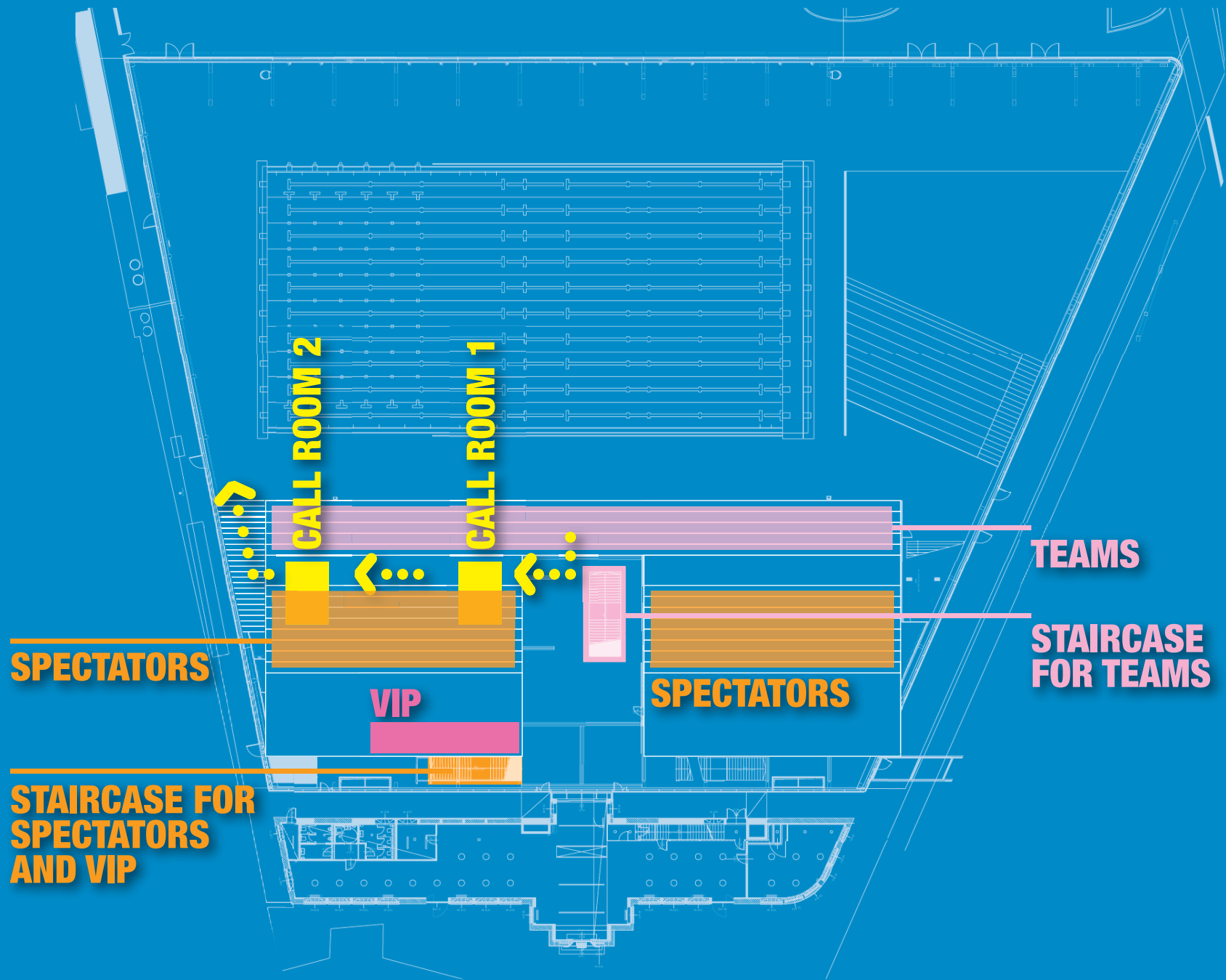
